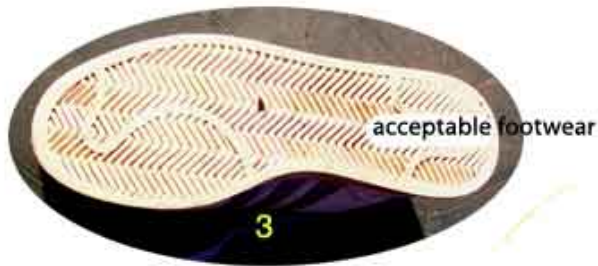


# Safety at Snowy River



Elastic sides are good ✓  
smooth soles are safe ✓

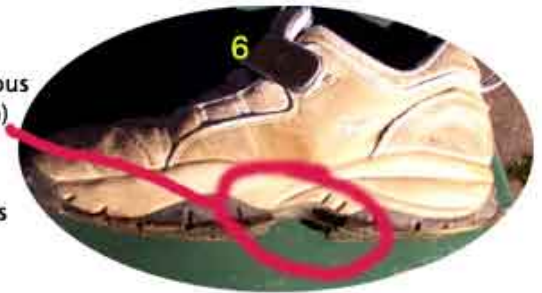


'Rough Tread'  
can make you dead  
(could catch on stirrup)



'Sole Indent' — dangerous  
(could catch on stirrup)

'Tongue & Laces' — dangerous  
(could catch in stirrup)



Horseriding footwear should be:

- narrow,
- heeled,
- smooth soled,
- non lace up

Short leather or synthetic riding boots presenting a smooth sole and solid heel (the depth of pattern should not exceed 2mm) are ideal.

Sandshoes are acceptable, Smooth soled!!!

**UNACCEPTABLE** horseriding footwear:

(see photos)

- \* Footwear with big tread
- \* insole indents
- \* side lugs, ALL are unsafe.
- \* heavy gumboots, walking boots,
- \* and desert boots are unacceptable.
- \* wide footwear
- \* protruding tongues
- \* Blundstones, Doc Martens,

Riding helmets are provided by SRC , however students may bring their own helmet providing it conforms to safety standard AS/NZS 3838:1998

**Jodhpurs** are designed for riding, however long fitting stretch pants preferably without an inside seam are recommended to prevent rubbing. Skirts, shorts, and pants with buttons down the legs are not permitted.
